

This Month: Church communities celebrate Jesus.

This month we will hear the beloved Christmas story. We begin with the annunciation to Mary. An angel tells her that she is going to have a very special baby—God's son, Jesus. Then, we hear Joseph's story. Joseph is engaged to Mary, but she's pregnant and this usually means public ridicule. Joseph doesn't want that to happen to her, and as he's thinking about what to do, he has a dream.

In the dream, an angel tells Joseph that Jesus is God's son and that it is okay to marry Mary. Then, Mary and Joseph make the long trek to Bethlehem to be counted for taxes. While they are there, Jesus is born and laid in a manger—an animal feeding trough. The shepherds in a nearby field are visited by angels who announce Jesus' birth.
